Exhibit "A" Geocache Rules & Regulations

Geocache/Letterbox/Munzee/Quest/Other Hidden Objects

("Geocache" or "cache" is used to refer to all hide and seek locations/containers.)

- 1. All caches should be publicly listed on their affiliated websites.
- 2. Geocaches should be monitored regularly and properly maintained (recommended monthly).
- 3. Cache contents are to be family appropriate. Tobacco, alcohol, drugs, firearms, dangerous items, food, and adult items are prohibited. Inappropriate caches will be removed and discarded without notice.
- 4. Containers used cannot be ammo cans, PVC pipes, or have the appearance of a dangerous object or resemble anything that might cause public harm.
- 5. Geocaches should be placed within 10 feet of an established trail.
- 6. Placement and access to the container cannot damage any park property, remove or negatively impact vegetation or wildlife, and cannot be placed where participants must climb up rocks or up trees to access the container.
- 7. All information on geocaches in SCPD parks must be free. No premium paid-level or private caches permitted.
- 8. Certain areas within the SCPD are restricted due to the land management, sensitive habitats, or safety concerns.
- 9. The cache owner must abide by all SCPD rules and regulations, including park hours (open sunrise to sunset) and being aware of hunting seasons when selecting locations.
