

April 2024 Operations Department Report

BOWEN NATURE PRESERVE

- Work continues on the interior of the house, with more window repairs and painting scheduled throughout the year.
- The parking lot is set to be resealed and striped in May.

CLINTON NATURE PRESERVE

The base for the entry sign has been completed.

FORREST NATURE PRESERVE

 New trail posts and signage for the upper and lower areas will be completed and installed this summer.

ST. JOHN'S MILL RIVER ACCESS

- We have begun the process of working with the state for use of our ODOT Metroparks funding for installation of a new asphalt parking lot. M&B has been contracted for the project and we are on their schedule for the week of June 10.
- The entry sign and bulletin board will be installed once parking lot is complete.



STEYER NATURE PRESERVE

 Preparations are underway to create a working office/shop space in the south block building (part of the old migrant camp)

ALL AREAS

- Daily schedules are monopolized by mowing, weed control, and spring clean-up.
- Kim has been working with the health department to acquire a grant for AEDs, so they can be placed in parks that have operations offices/shops buildings.
