



## April 2024 Operations Department Report

### **BOWEN NATURE PRESERVE**

- Work continues on the interior of the house, with more window repairs and painting scheduled throughout the year.
- The parking lot is set to be resealed and striped in May.

### **CLINTON NATURE PRESERVE**

- The base for the entry sign has been completed.

### **FORREST NATURE PRESERVE**

- New trail posts and signage for the upper and lower areas will be completed and installed this summer.

### **ST. JOHN'S MILL RIVER ACCESS**

- We have begun the process of working with the state for use of our ODOT Metroparks funding for installation of a new asphalt parking lot. M&B has been contracted for the project and we are on their schedule for the week of June 10.
- The entry sign and bulletin board will be installed once parking lot is complete.



### **STEYER NATURE PRESERVE**

- Preparations are underway to create a working office/shop space in the south block building (part of the old migrant camp)

### **ALL AREAS**

- Daily schedules are monopolized by mowing, weed control, and spring clean-up.
- Kim has been working with the health department to acquire a grant for AEDs, so they can be placed in parks that have operations offices/shops buildings.
