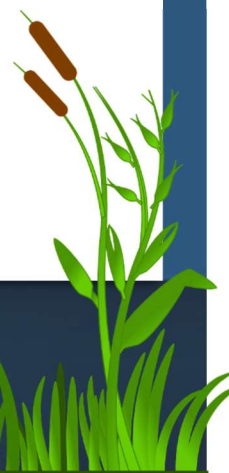
“WALK & WREAD”
