2024 BUDGET PLANNING:

An updated 2024 Park Budget Estimate has been reviewed by the Finance and Audit Committee, with additional insight provided by the County Auditor's office. Julie Adkins, Co. Auditor, informed departments of the status of House Bill 187 and Senate Bill 153 and the ramifications of what those bills could do to county budgets, should they pass.

She recommended that departments be as prepared as possible for delay of funding next year by carrying over as much cash as possible. The first funding of the year, which is normally received in April, could come in June next year as it will take additional time for her office to implement what is passed in the proposed Bill.
