ST. JOHN'S MILL RIVER ACCESS:

Using our ODOT Metroparks funds through OPRA, we will be checking to see if all the stonework for a parking lot can be installed this year with asphalt to follow next year, when the next biennium of funding comes available.

CNP PARKING & ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS:

Improvements to Clinton Nature Preserve took place over the winter to be ready for the spring opening April 1.

Improvements include: larger gravel parking area, longer riverbank access to the south, river trail opening, and signage. As directed by ODNR, an additional vehicle barrier was also installed to keep pedestrians safe from unauthorized vehicles attempting to drive the length of the walking/biking trail, that extends from Clinton Nature Preserve through Schekelhoff Nature Preserve.

PROGRAMMING MEETING WITH FELC:
