#### HOUSE BILL 47 - AEDs

Although the Seneca Parks are exempt from this Bill, as is most other Townships and Villages in Ohio, the Seneca Parks have already initiated the acquisition of AEDs in cooperation with the Seneca Health Department earlier this year and plan to acquire more units in the future to place at permanent building facilities in the parks across the county.
