CONTINUING EDUCATION / TRAINING / PROGRAMMING

- The maintenance dept. attended a field day in Perrysburg to learn about new electric Toro products, these as well as the automated mower are very costly. (Between \$32,000-\$40,000)

PARK OPERATIONS / PROJECTS

- BNP Coming out of CRP, the area will be reevaluated and mowing patterns will be increased
- CNP A no trespassing sign was placed at the land owners request in attempts to prevent people from accessing his land
- Stone work will be done this fall along the driving path and sign, to include a walk way around the gate for winter walkers
- FNP Tiles and a stone path was added beside the walking bridge
- FWNP Attica Lumber will be starting the 4-bay garage at the beginning of Oct.
- The story book trail will be installed this fall
- GHNP Signs have been posted and posts have been placed to discourage driving on the walking paths
- Grass has been removed around the new barn and stone work has begun to add a drive around the building
- MCNP Trail maintenance and tree removal
- OP Dirt mounding and a sledding hill has been incorporated along the future new path
- Additional soil and seed will be added around the trees at the playground
- SNP Rough work, stone removal, tile work and grading are underway. Blocks, repurposed from the old bridge that was once there, have been added for better footing at the base of the steps.
- SJM Fall mowing has been completed, brush and tree removal is planned for this winter
- TUNP Area is being monitored for any maintenance issues
- ZNP 3 hazardous trees were removed from around the shelter area
- All Areas: Fall maintenance has begun in all areas
