- Photos need to be mounted on foam board/cardboard.
- Photographer's name, age, address, phone number, title of photo and location need to be listed on the back of the photo.
- Youth photo entries must be taken at one of the 12 Seneca Parks (Bowen, Clary Boluee McDonald, Clinton, Forrest, Fruth Wetland, Garlo Heritage, Mercy Community, Opportunity, Steyer, St. John's Mill River Access, Tiffin University or Zimmerman Nature Preserve).
- Limit of 5 photos per person.

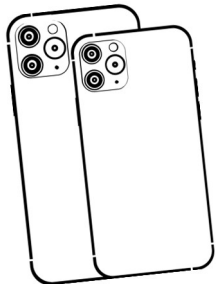
ADULT PHOTO GUIDELINES

- Photo contest open to any amateur photographer.
- All photos must be 8x10 (exception: youth contest).
- **Photos must be mounted on 8 x 10 foam board.**
No frames or mats.
- Entries may be either color or black and white.
- Limit of 2 entries per person, per category.
- Each entry must have a label or the following information on the back of the photo: Photographer's name, address and phone number, category entered, photo title, email, and location where photo was taken.
- \$10 entry fee per person, allows entry of up to 2 photos per category (up to 8 total). Make \$10 checks payable to: Seneca County Park District
- **Deadline to enter is 4PM Tuesday, June 30, 2026**
- Entries can be mailed or dropped off at the Park Office:

Park District Scenes— Mercy Community Nature Preserve is the focus of this year's park district scenes. Photos must be taken at this park and depict the park. **Photographs of animals as the main subject of the photo will not be accepted in this category.**

Wildlife—Any wild animal found in one of the 12 Seneca Parks locations

Nature—Scenic landscapes, trees, wildflowers, found in one of the 12 Seneca Parks locations

Open—Any subject or location
